ACTS- Church On Mission

Part 30- The "Acts" Of The Holy Spirit

- <u>VS. 3-6-</u> "About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God come in & say to him, "Cornelius." And he stared at him in terror & said, "What is it, Lord?" And he said to him, "Your prayers & your alms have ascended as a memorial before God. And now send men to Joppa & bring one Simon who is called Peter. He is lodging w/ one Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea."
- VS. 10-16- "And he became hungry & wanted something to eat, but while they were preparing it, he fell into a trance & saw the heavens opened & something like a great sheet descending, being let down by its four corners upon the earth. In it were all kinds of animals & reptiles & birds of the air. And there came a voice to him: "Rise, Peter; kill & eat." But Peter said, "By no means, Lord; for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean." And the voice came to him again a second time, "What God has made clean, do not call common." This happened three times, & the thing was taken up at once to heaven."
- VS. 19-20- "And while Peter was pondering the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are looking for you. Rise & go down & accompany them w/ out hesitation, for I have sent them."
- <u>VS. 22</u>- "And they said, "Cornelius, a centurion, an upright & God-fearing man, who is well spoken of by the whole Jewish nation, was directed by a holy angel to send for you to come to his house & to hear what you have to say."
- <u>VS. 30</u>- "And Cornelius said, "Four days ago, about this hour, I was praying in my house at the ninth hour, & behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing"
- <u>VS. 44- 46-</u> "While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. And the believers from among the circumcised who had come w/ Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles. For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God..."
- <u>VS. 3-6-</u> "About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God come in & say to him, "Cornelius." And he stared at him in terror & said, "What is it, Lord?" 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<u>VS. 44</u>- "While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word."

Acts 8:29- "And the Spirit said to Philip, "Go over & join this chariot."

Acts 13:4- "So being sent out by the Holy Spirit..."

Acts 20:22- "And now, behold, I am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the Spirit, not knowing what will happen to me there,"

Acts 16:6-7- "And they went through the region of Phrygia & Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them."

<u>1 Corinthians 12:11</u>- "All these are empowered by one & the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills."

John 14:15-17- ""If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, & he will give you another Helper, to be w/ you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells w/ you & will be in you"

<u>John 14:26</u>- "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, <u>he will teach you all things</u> & bring to your remembrance <u>all that I have said</u> to you."

John 15:26- "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me."

John 16:5-15- "But now I am going to him who sent me, & none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin & righteousness & judgment: concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, & you will see me no longer; concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his

own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, & he will declare to you the things that are to come. <u>He will glorify me</u>, for he will take what is mine & declare it to you. All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine & declare it to you"

Corinthians 12:2-3- "You know that when you were pagans you were led astray to mute idols, however you were led. Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is accursed!" & no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit."

<u>VS. 15</u>- "And the voice came to him again a second time, "What God has made clean, do not call common."

VS. 25-26- "When Peter entered, Cornelius met him & fell down at his feet & worshiped him. But Peter lifted him up, saying, "Stand up; I too am a man."

<u>VS. 34-43</u>- Boldly proclaims Jesus is Lord of All, appointed Judge of the living & the dead, the One whom the prophets bear witness to & the One whom through forgiveness of sins is possible

Acts 11:13-14- Angel told Cornelius the message they would have declared to them would lead to salvation

Acts 11:17- The result of their baptism is a believing in the "Lord Jesus Christ"-Great picture of Jesus being Lord & Christ/Savior

<u>Galatians 6:8-</u> "For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life."
