ACTS: Church On Mission Part 50- Receiving The Holy Spirit

Acts 19:1-17- "And it happened that while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the inland country & came to Ephesus. There he found some disciples. And he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they said, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They said, "Into John's baptism." And Paul said, "John baptized w/ the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, Jesus." On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, & they began speaking in tongues & prophesying. There were about twelve men in all."
