ACTS: Church On Mission Part 55 - Haircuts For The Sake Of The Gospel Acts 21:17-36

<u>VS. 17-20a</u>- "When we had come to Jerusalem the brothers received us gladly. On the following day Paul went in w/ us to James, & all the elders were present. After greeting them, he related one by one the things that God had done among the Gentiles through his ministry. And when they heard it, they glorified God"

VS. 20b-22- "And they said to him, "You see, brother, how many thousands there are among the Jews of those who have believed. They are all zealous for the law, & they have been told about you that you teach all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, telling them not to circumcise their children or walk according to our customs. What then is to be done?"

VS. 23-25- "Do therefore what we tell you. We have four men who are under a vow; take these men & purify yourself along w/ them & pay their expenses, so that they may shave their heads. Thus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, but that you yourself also live in observance of the law. But as for the Gentiles who have believed, we have sent a letter w/ our judgment that they should abstain from what has been sacrificed to idols, & from blood, & from what has been strangled, & from sexual immorality."

VS. 26- "Then Paul took the men, & the next day he purified himself along w/ them & went into the temple, giving notice when the days of purification would be fulfilled & the offering presented for each one

Vs. 27.36- "When the seven days were almost completed, the Jews from Asia, seeing him in the temple, stirred up the whole crowd & laid hands on him, crying out, "Men of Israeh, help! This is the man who is teaching everyone everywhere against the people & the law & this place, (gossip gets bigger) Moreover, he even brought Greeks into the temple & has deflied this holy place." For they had previously seen Trophimus the Ephesian w/ him in the city, & they supposed that Paul had brought him into the temple, & the state of the temple, & at once the gates were shut. And as they were seeking to kill him, work came to the tribune of the cohort that all Jerusalem was in confusion. He at once took soldiers & centurions & ran down to them. And when they saw the tribune & the soldiers, they stopped beating Paul. Then the tribune came up & arrested him & ordered him to be bound w/ two chains. He inquired who he was & what he had done. Some in the crowd were shouting one thing, some another, And as he could not learn the facts because of when he came to the steps, he was actually carried by the soldiers because of the violence of the crowd, for the mob of the people followed, crying out, "Away w/ him!"
